Dear Ms. Allen:

I am writing to update you on the status of the above referenced transcript. By copy of this letter, I am also advising the South Carolina Court of Appeals of the current status since Mr. McGarr had previously written the Court of Appeals about his having not received the transcript timely. Let me first give you a timeline of events leading up to present.

I received the transcript request from Mr. Marc McGarr sometime late June/mid July 2016 shortly before my retirement. Upon receipt of the request, I sent my usual letter requesting an up-front payment before beginning production. Shortly after, I received a telephone call from Mr. McGarr explaining that in order to make the full payment up-front, he would need to go through the insurance company and provide them with a W9 from me; however, he could pay me a deposit up to \$499 from his firm account without the jumping through those hoops. We agreed that I would accept the \$499 deposit and bill the remainder upon completion of the transcript. I received his deposit on July 28, 2016 and began work on the transcript shortly after.

I completed the transcript on December 23rd, and since the transcript was overdue, I emailed Mr. McGarr a complimentary pdf of the transcript (along with my invoice) to expedite his receiving it. Shortly after the Christmas holidays I mailed the original hard copy of the transcript and my invoice via USPS Priority Mail to Mr. McGarr.

To date, Mr. McGarr has not completed payment of the remaining due on the transcript. I have both emailed and called him with no response. I am mailing a second invoice to Mr. McGarr today.

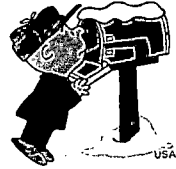
