MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF


1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Shaquan Thompson v. State with this Court on January 19, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Corey Jamal Williams with this Court on January 18, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Cheo D. Green with the Court of Appeals on January 17, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Joel Robinson v. State with this Court on January 13, 2017. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. 5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




