ORDER

By order dated June 23, 2016, Chief Justice Pleicones dismissed this matter. On September 7, 2016, this Court denied a petition for rehearing.

Petitioner has now filed a motion seeking relief in this case. Among other things, he alleges that the signatures on the order of September 7, 2016, are forgeries.

There is simply no basis for petitioner's assertion that any of these signatures are forgeries. The signatures on the order of September 7, 2016, accurately reflect the vote taken by this Court on the petition for rehearing.


