According to the York County case no. 2016CP-46941: which was filed on December 28, 2016 and I have received the copy of the letter on January 3, 2017 ABC Leasing, Inc, I have to pay \$5456.71.

I do not agree with it because of the following reasons:

1. I was tricked by Mr. Joseph Toth from Blackstone Company, the man who installed the Touch n Buy machine in my store. There was no written number of contract on the paper works that he made me sign. He just took the papers with him without leaving a copy of them. A week later, he wrote the 48 months contract on the paper and mailed it to me.
2. The machine does not work properly: that means, it did not accept a

single customer's utility bills nor phone bills as it mentioned on the manual. Because of that, I had to pay \$92.11 a month out of pocket.

3. I was arguing Mr. Joseph Toth to send me a statement that shows how much money I was making. The prepaid phone cards money sold at the store was drafted out of my bank account every week without any statement.

On top of all of these, I gave away 19 government cell phones. Mr. Joseph told me that I would receive \$4.00 promotion from each phone given away to the food stamp recipients'. After he found out that I stopped the machine, he made a phone call to tell me that I could not do that; I explained him everything in detail. First, I was calling him three to four times a day to tell him I had a problem with the machine: he wouldn't do anything; sometimes he wouldn't answer his phone. Second, I did not get paid for the prepaid phone cards or the \$4.00 from each government cell phones given away. When I mentioned about the \$4.00, he became nervous, and told me that it was not \$4.00; it was \$8.00 each. I asked him where the money was, he did not say anything.

Before these things took place, Mr. Joseph came to my store four to five times to convince me saying; "your store is very good location, you are going to make tones of money, this is the only store going to carry the touch n buy machine": which is all false.

After several trips to my store, Mr. Joseph convinced me, he did all the things he wanted to do, and refused to help me while I was dealing with the malfunctioning machine every day.

This case needs to be justified and Mr. Joseph Toth must take accountability for all charges (\$5,456.71) and for the money that I should have to

get paid from the prepaid phone cards and government cell phones. He has to be brought to justice.
