ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on September 18, 2012, due to Appellant's failure to provide proof of service for the record on appeal. Appellant has filed a petition to reinstate this appeal and requested Respondent to provide copies of four items designated by Respondent to be included in the record on appeal. Within ten days, Respondent shall furnish to Appellant one copy of "the Transcript from the 11/7/2011 hearing . . . , the Order denying relief from judgment dated 11/21/2011, the notice of hearing for the Restraining Order, and the affidavit of default." Respondent may charge reasonable copying fees. Within ten days from receiving the copies, Appellant shall serve the record on appeal and file with this Court a proof of service for the record on appeal. This Court will act on the petition to reinstate upon receipt of the proof of service or expiration of twenty days.
