
NOW COMES Petitioner in the above captioned Post-Conviction Relief appeal, acting by and through his undersigned counsel, asking for leave to submit an Amended Petition for Writ of Certiorari for the purpose of correcting the four (4) typographical errors detailed below.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this Post-Conviction Relief appeal was filed on February 13, 2017. Counsel for Petitioner has now discovered that four (4) dates referenced on pages 20, 21 and 22 reflect the proper month and day, but the incorrect year. Those errors are as follows:

1. Page 20, paragraph 2 states, "Petitioner's acceptance of that deal on January 17, 2014 ..." and should read January 17, 2012.
2. Page 21, lines 1-2 states, "made note of the plea offer extended to Petitioner being set to expire January 3, 2014 ..." and should have read January 3, 2012.
3. Page 22, line 4 states, "Extended on December 20, 2013 and repeated January 3, 2014." This portion of the conclusion should have read, "Extended on December 20, 2011 and repeated January 3, 2012."

Counsel for Petitioner has brought these errors to the attention of opposing counsel, Assistant Attorney General Justin J. Hunter, and he has graciously consented to Petitioner's request to file an Amended Petition correcting these four (4) typographical errors. Petitioner now asks for leave of Court to file his Amended Petition for Writ of Certiorari which has been submitted to the Court along with this motion.


