MOTION TO FILE
SUPPLEMENTAL APPENDIX

Counsel for William Gregg seeks to supplement the Appendix pursuant to Rule 243(f), SCACR. In support of this motion counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari, Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari Pursuant to Austin v. State, and copies of the Appendix were served and filed on February 8, 2017.

2. On March 7, 2017, counsel received a letter from Petitioner Gregg dated March 2, 2017 requesting counsel supplement the record with Petitioner's *pro se* Request for a Belated Direct Appeal Pursuant to White v. State filed with the Sumter County Clerk of Court on July 1, 2009 and Petitioner's *pro se* Motion to Relieve Counsel Charles T. Brooks filed with the Sumter

County Clerk of Court on September 17, 2009. Presumably, Petitioner Gregg seeks to cite to these documents in his *pro se* response to the petition filed by undersigned counsel. Petitioner's *pro se* Request for a Belated Direct Appeal Pursuant to White v. State is also relevant to the relief Petitioner seeks in the Petition for Writ of Certiorari filed by counsel. Moreover, the Order of Dismissal indicates that the PCR court had before it the Sumter County Clerk of Court records. App. 569.



Therefore, inasmuch as Rule 243(f)(1), SCACR, requires a copy of the entire lower court record be included in the Appendix, counsel requests leave to file a supplemental appendix containing Petitioner's *pro se* Request for a Belated Direct Appeal Pursuant to White v. State filed with the Sumter County Clerk of Court on July 1, 2009 and Petitioner's *pro se* Motion to Relieve Counsel Charles T. Brooks filed with the Sumter County Clerk of Court on September 17, 2009

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. The Supplemental Appendix is being filed simultaneously with this motion.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel respectfully requests this Court to allow the Appendix to be supplemented to include Petitioner's *pro se* Request for a Belated Direct Appeal Pursuant to White v. State and Petitioner's *pro se* Motion to Relieve Counsel Charles T. Brooks based on the above circumstances.




