RETURN TO THIRD MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME


COMES NOW Respondent Quarter Point Ventures, LLC

This matter originally concluded in July 2016, from a real estate transaction that was to have closed in August 2015. After a subsequent motion for reconsideration this matter was concluded on August 31, 2016, after which Appellant timely filed its Notice of Appeal on September 29, 2016.
