STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The issue in this case involves the issue of
Barrett through Statement of the Counsel of Record.
The South Carolina Code on Law Title 16, Chapter 17, Article 3,
Sec. 16-17-10 (c) (b) clearly states that the court
can not be misled. The introduction of federal law
matters into a state court that have not been
determined by the court or last resort, is misleading,
as no final decision has been made in the federal
matters.

It concludes, federal matters are for the Federal
Court and they must be heard under United States
Senate (USS) related requirements. States are subordinate

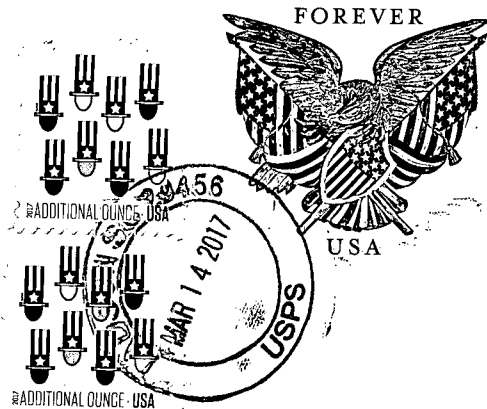
