MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Kevin C. Casey respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Kevin C. Casey respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel appeared in general session's court in Florence County for a hearing on the state's motion to dismiss the defendant's motion for resentencing in State v. Ronald Mack on February 17, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in State v. Stephon Robinson with the Court of Appeals today, February 13, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in William Patrick Deaton v. State with this Court on February 13, 2017. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Alonda B. Desaussure v. State with this Court on February 7, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. David Glover with the Court of Appeals on January 24, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Boyd Rashaeen Evans v. State with this Court on January 20, 2017. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Calvin Terrell Williams with the Court of Appeals on January 18, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon




