MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR ASSEMBLING, PREPARING, VERIFYING,
OBTAINING THE MATERIAL, COMPLETING AND SERVING THE RECORD ON
APPEAL ACCURATELY

I, Ann Stevenson, hereby request a Time Extension until May 2, 2017 to accurately complete and serve the Record on Appeal in the above-captioned appeal for the following reasons:

- 1) As my attorney refused to give me access to my file in April 2013, later sent me some pieces of it and sold me the copy in April 2016 of the Hearing Transcript dated January 8, 2015, he had acquired in January 2016 which was necessary to file the appeal, and most lawyers coming before the Court of Appeals have a complete case file, they do not usually have to piece it together as I have had to look for information from Mr. Baxley, the Worker's Comp Commission and elsewhere in order to get truthful, accurate, and readable information. Not everything coming in is accurate, some discrepancies, and some may have been mishandled by those attorneys entering it into evidence and possibly others.
- 2) When I contacted Coral Strickland to get a copy of Dr. Merritt's Deposition, there were no color pictures or pictures of any kind. My lawyer did not supply a copy, WC Commission said I would have to get from the transcriber, but on another visit there were no clear color pictures attached to it or otherwise included in the WCC file in Columbia.

- 3) We are looking for the emails listed in Mr. Baxley's #6 of his Designation of Matter.
- 4) There is evidence that has been tampered with, is missing, and possibly not entered into the file.
- 5) There is material in the Appellant's Amended Designation of Matter that was not stricken and needs to be added which was already in the case in audio/transcript.
- 6) There is material which was attached to form 58 that should not have been stricken, because it was admitted into evidence.
- 7) The complications and consequences prior to, during, and after the unanticipated death of my husband, Denny of more than thirty years in three different hospitals along with the physical trauma and sleepless grieving of mine and my pets, the older of which has panic attacks beating on the bedroom door about every 2 hours or more during the overnight sleep cycle. Other court paperwork required for probate issues.
- 8) This is my first time doing this and want to produce the best Record possible that is accurate.

For these and many other reasons, In The Pursuit of Justice and Producing the Most Accurate and Complete Legal Record, I respectfully request this time extension,

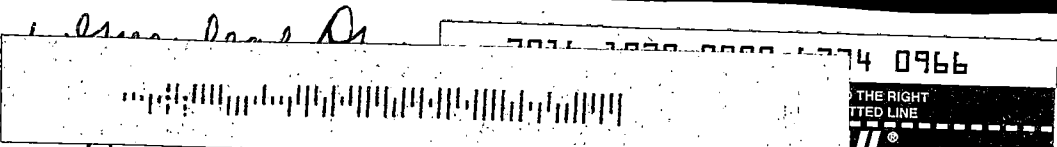

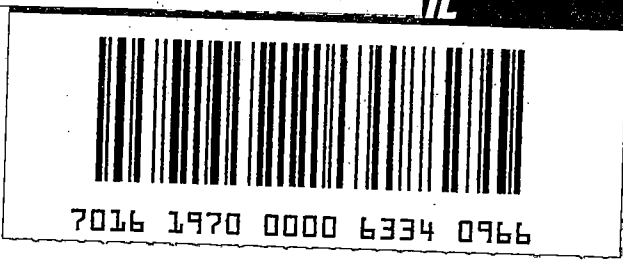
