Dear Ms. Gee:

On about June 1, 2012, I received the transcript of the second hearing, in which a different circuit judge, the Honorable Marvin Duke, dismissed Defendants Matyushetky and CODA from the case. There is still one defendant Christine Varg remaining in the case.

The referenced case is ready to proceed on briefs. I have already written the court before that I received the transcript of the first hearing in which Defendant LiLing Sun was dismissed by Circuit Judge Carmen Mullen. Since the transcript of the second hearing is also needed for the appeal of the first dismissal, Case Manager Seth Tucker informed me that the time line would begin after I received the second part of the transcript. Because the facts and arguments are related, and the two (2) transcripts of the two hearings may be cross referenced, it would be more efficient and save court time if the court would combine the two Appeals into one. I am leaving this decision of consolidation to the court to act on its own.

Please let me know if the court would consolidate the two appeals or require a separate motion for the consolidation because I am not able to send in the \$25 filing fee at this time.
