**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH

I.

The Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter are due to be served and filed on today's date, March 20, 2017.

II.

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the State moves for a **third** extension in the above-referenced criminal appeal and asks for an additional thirty days to complete the brief in this case. In the past few weeks, the undersigned has submitted a Return to a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in Ronald Tillman v. State, a Return

to a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in Phillip Crocker, III v. State, Return to a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in Clinton Folkes v. State, and a Return to a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in State v. Daniel Martinez Herrera to the South Carolina Supreme Court. Additionally, the undersigned has submitted an Initial Brief of Respondent in State v. Robert Max Watkins, and Initial Brief of Respondent in State v. Brandon Berry, an Initial Brief of Appellant in State v. John Kenneth Massey, Jr., and Initial Brief of Respondent in State v. Keith Christopher Osborne, to this Court.

This extension request is not intended for purposes of delay, but rather to ensure that the Brief is properly researched and prepared. The Brief in the above case has required substantial research because the case involves significant issues on appeal. The undersigned is currently working on the Brief in this case and hopes to have it completed in a timely manner. The State would therefore request an extension of time within which to serve and file the Brief.


