

ORDER

This Court dismissed this appeal on January 26, 2017, due to Appellant's failure to pay the notice of appeal filing fee. Appellant failed to timely petition for rehearing. This Court sent the remittitur down on February 14, 2017. Appellant now seeks to recall the remittitur. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Because Appellant failed to timely file a petition for rehearing, remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Accordingly, Appellant's motion to recall the remittitur is hereby denied.
