

Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- You must specifically name each order you wish to appeal in your notice of appeal. In particular, the notice of appeal refers to "orders underlying said order."
- The proof of service of the notice of appeal is not dated as to when it was served.
- One of the respondents named in the notice of appeal, Tad Barner, does not seem to appear as a party in this case on any of the orders provided. You must confirm his recognition as a party by providing a copy of the summons, complaint, or order naming him.
