

DENY DISMISSAL.

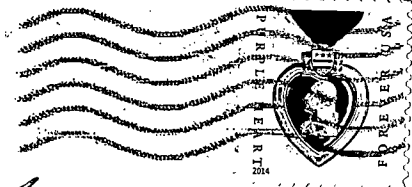
