

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in David Lee Coward v. State with this Court on February 22, 2017. Counsel appeared in general session's court in Florence County for a hearing on the state's motion to dismiss the defendant's motion for resentencing in State v. Ronald Mack on February 17, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in State v. Stephon Robinson with the Court of Appeals today, February 13, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in William Patrick Deaton v. State with this Court on February 13, 2017. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Alonda B. Desaussure v. State with this Court on February 7, 2017.

3. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.

4. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty day extension, until April 28, 2017**. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


