I received a Motion For Correction Of The Record On Appeal from Atty. Please received this letter and filed as a response to Respondents' Motion For Correction Of The Record On Appeal.

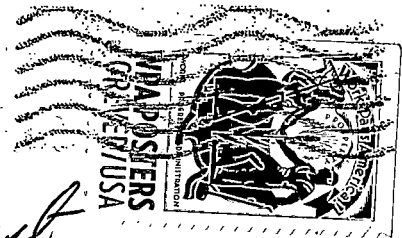
