

ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, arguing the order from which appeal was taken is not immediately appealable. Respondent asserts Appellants must first file a motion pursuant to Rule 60(b), SCRPC, with the circuit court and appeal from the resulting order. In their filings, the parties informed this court such a motion is currently pending before the circuit court. After careful consideration, we find it appropriate to hold this appeal in abeyance and remand in part to the circuit court for consideration of Appellants' motion. Counsel for Appellants shall contact counsel for Respondent and the circuit court within ten days of this order to schedule such hearings as the circuit court deems appropriate. Counsel for Appellants shall provide a status update to the clerk of this court within fifteen days of this order and every thirty days thereafter, with a copy to counsel for Respondent. This appeal will be held in abeyance pending the circuit court's resolution of this matter.
