
We have received the following items from you regarding your above referenced appeal: letter explaining service date for record on appeal with a money order in the amount of \$25.00, a motion with a money order in the amount of \$25.00, proof of service for a notice of appeal, correspondence containing an excerpt from the South Carolina Code of Laws, and a proof of service for an unnamed document. The following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The Court's letter of March 13, 2017 requested that you provide a proof of service for your record on appeal stating exactly what document was served and exactly what day it was served. While the Court appreciates the effort you went through in giving a written explanation of the two different dates and providing a filing fee, neither were necessary and the filing fee is being returned to you with this letter.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service

for your motion should clearly state the document being served, the names and addresses of all parties served, as well as the exact date they were served.

Please file both of these documents no later than April 10, 2017. The proof of service for the record on appeal should only contain information for when the record on appeal was served and only mention the record on appeal and not any other document. Proof of service for your motion should be filed at the same time and only contain information regarding the service of that document.
