

The above-captioned matter was heard by the Administrative Law Court ("Court") on February 22, 2012 and a decision was issued on June 15, 2012. On October 5, 2012, the Appellant filed a Motion to Compel Compliance with Court Order and Enjoin Further Agency Proceedings. The Appellant filed a Response on October 9, 2012. The Appellant filed a Reply on October 10, 2012.


The Court disagrees with the Appellant's argument. The Court found that the notice of the original Board hearing was insufficient to comport with procedural due process and remanded the decision to LLR, directing the agency to rehear the Appellant's license renewal application. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Appellant's Motion to Compel Compliance with Court Order and Enjoin Further Agency Proceedings is denied. The Respondent shall schedule and rehear the case at a meeting of the Board.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
