ORDER

On May 9, 2016, this court dismissed Appellant's appeal from the circuit court's order of January 27, 2015, granting summary judgment and the circuit court's subsequent order denying reconsideration. Appellant did not file a motion to reinstate the appeal, and this court remitted the appeal on May 25, 2016. Appellant then filed a motion to reinstate the appeal and for other relief with the circuit court, which the circuit court denied for lack of jurisdiction.

Appellant has now filed a new notice of appeal from the order of summary judgment, the order denying reconsideration, and the order denying Appellant's motion to reinstate and for relief. Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss and requests sanctions. Because this court has already dismissed Appellant's appeal from the order of summary judgment and the order denying reconsideration and because the circuit court properly denied Appellant's motion to reinstate for lack of jurisdiction, the motion to dismiss is granted. The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR. Respondent's request for sanctions is denied.
