## ORDER

After careful consideration of the filings in this case, the Court concludes that the notice of appeal stems from an action related to the revocation of the appellant's medical staff privileges. Accordingly, the appellant's pro se filings are refused and this appeal is dismissed. *Doe v. Duncan*, S.C. Sup. Ct. order dated December 2, 2009 ("[W]e hereby direct the Clerks of Court in this state to refuse to accept further filings from [Holmes] in actions related in any way to the revocation of her medical staff privileges. . . unless they are filed by an attorney, other than [Holmes], licensed to practice law in this state.").
