Dear Commissioner Beck:

Pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws Title 15 - Civil Remedies and Procedures CHAPTER 27
ARTICLE 1 SECTION 15-27-155

(A) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, whenever a party or witness to a civil legal proceeding does not sufficiently speak the English language to testify, the court may appoint a qualified interpreter to interpret the proceedings and the testimony of the party or witness.

(D) The Division of Court Administration shall maintain a centralized list of qualified interpreters

to interpret the proceedings to and testimony of a party or witness.

Pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws Section 42-3-20(C) the Commission has a duty to hear and determine all contested cases and, pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws Section 42-3-180, to determine all questions arising under Title 42 of the South Carolina Code of Laws; and

WHEREAS, Article I Section 3 of the South Carolina Constitution states, in part, that "nor shall any person be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law, nor shall any person be denied the equal protection of the laws;" and

WHEREAS, many persons who come before the Commission are partially or completely excluded from full participation in the proceedings due to limited English proficiency or a speech or hearing impairment and it is essential that this communication barrier must be removed, as much as possible, so that these persons are placed in the same position as a similarly situated person for whom there is no such barrier;

Claimant request this Commission an appointed Interpreter for the incoming hearing scheduled for September 01, 2015 at 01:15 PM at County Square, 301 University Ridge, Suite 5100, East Wing Greenville, SC 29601.
