5 1/2 years 51%

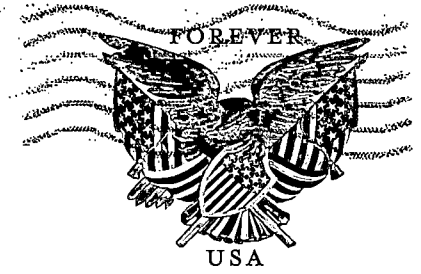
I get my original 15 year sentence
