This Court has received your motion for bond. By copy of this letter, the State is requested to serve and file a return to this motion by April 20, 2017.¹

In light of your appearance in this case, the records of this Court, which previously reflected that Mr. Williams was proceeding *pro se* in this case, now reflect that you are his counsel of record in this case.


I am enclosing a copy of correspondence that Mr. Williams has sent regarding concerns he has about the transcript and his belief that the appendix needs to contain additional documents. Since you now represent him, if it is appropriate to seek relief from this Court regarding the transcript or to supplement the appendix with additional documents, that request will have to be filed by you as his counsel. *Miller*

¹ The caption of your motion reflects that Mr. Williams is a cross-petitioner in this case. Please be advised that Mr. William's motion to withdraw his notice of appeal was granted by order dated March 3, 2017, and the remittitur was sent as to that portion of this case on March 28, 2017. Therefore, the State is now the only petitioner in this case.

v. State, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989).

Finally, this Court did receive a *pro se* return from petitioner regarding the State's petition for a writ of certiorari. If you intend to move to withdraw this *pro se* filing so that you can file a return on his behalf, that request should be filed within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.²
