In this post-conviction relief case, petitioner has filed notices of appeal from a conditional order of dismissal and an order imposing restrictions on future filings.

By statute and rule, only a final judgment or decision is appealable in a post-conviction relief case. *Lewis v. State*, 368 S.C. 630, 630 S.E.2d 464 (2006). Since the circuit court has not issued a final judgment or decision in this case, the notices of appeal are dismissed without prejudice to petitioner's ability to seek review of the above orders in a timely appeal from the final judgment or decision of the circuit court in this case.
