
PETITION FOR EXTENSION

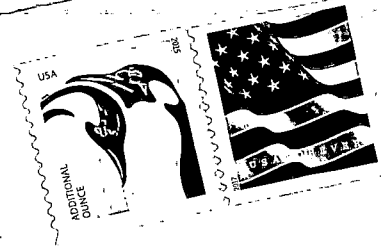
