RESPONDENT'S RETURN TO APPELLANT'S PETITION FOR CERTIORARI



The grounds raised by Appellants in their petition for petition for Writ of Certiorari constitute only, at most, mere errors of law which are insufficient under the “manifest disregard” standard. Gissel v. Hart, 382 S.C. 235, 241-242, 676 S.E.2d 320, 323-324 (2009); Batten v. Howell, 300 S.C. 545, 548, 389 S.E.2d 170, 172 (Ct. App. 1990). An arbitration award is conclusive and courts will refuse to review the merits of an award. Trident Technical College v. Lucas & Stubbs, Ltd., 286 S.C. 98, 333 S.E. (2d) 781 (1985). "Otherwise an arbitration award would signify 'the *commencement*, not the end, of litigation.'" Id. at 111, 333 S.E.2d at 789 (Emphasis in the original.) It is time for the instant action to end.

For the reasons stated above, this Court should DENY Appellant’s petition for certiorari.


