

ORDER

By order dated March 2, 2017, this matter was dismissed based on petitioner's failure to pay the filing fee. The remittitur was sent to the lower court on March 20, 2017. *See* Rule 220, SCACR (if no petition for rehearing is actually received by the Court within fifteen days after the filing of the order of the Court, the remittitur will be sent to the lower court). A petition for rehearing was received by this Court on March 21, 2017. Because the remittitur was properly sent to the lower court pursuant to Rule 220, this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the matter. *See Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Accordingly, no action will be taken on the petition for rehearing.¹
