1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today having been extended by three prior orders of this Court.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Archie Hoover v. State on October 4, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Terrance Gist v. State on October 1, 2012. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.




