
Dear Mr. Logan:

Upon reviewing your "motion to appeal dismissal," which this Court has construed as a notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(b) (6), SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
