ORDER

Appellant's counsel has filed a motion to be relieved, explaining that Appellant was represented by the Public Defender at the underlying civil hearing as an accommodation to Appellant and Appellant has been "released from custody and is now able to access property and resources he was unable to while incarcerated." Appellant was served with the motion, but he did not file a response.

Counsel's motion is granted. Appellant has thirty days to obtain new counsel, or this court will presume Appellant is proceeding pro se.
