

Once again, please send any issues in writing to the Court within twenty days from the date of this letter.

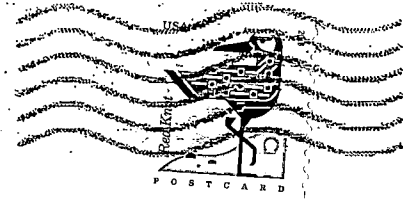
