In response to letter sent to me by April 12, 2017:

The order was filed in The State of South Carolina, County of York: in The Court of Common Pleas in December 28, 2016.

I arrived at the court house about 8 minutes late, and the clerk told me that the order was already filed. Five days later, on January 2, 2017: the court order letter was delivered to me. According to the judgment, I was ordered to the amount of \$5,456.71 which I did not agree with that. Soon, I started to write an appeal letter. In Feb. 8, 2017, I complete and mailed it to the Court of Common Pleas of the State of South Carolina.

The reason why I did not agree with it was:

1. There was no written number of contract on the agreement paper that I signed on. The person named Mr. Joseph Toth who installed the "touch n buy machine in my store made me sign on the paper, took it with him and wrote 48 months on it, and mailed me the copy of it about a week later.

2. The "touch n buy" machine was not working properly. Customers came to pay their phone and power bills; it did not take a single one.
3. Mr. Joseph Toth was drafting the money out of my account and did not pay me the percentage that I am supposed to get paid. In addition, he did not pay me \$8.00 each of 19 government cell phones that I gave them away.


Because of that I lost a lot of money, and I had to pay \$92.11 per month rent for the machine out of pocket. I remained helpless.

This case needs to be justified and Mr. Joseph Toth must take accountability for all charges (\$5,456.71) and for the money that I should have to get paid from the prepaid phone cards and the government cell phones. He has to be brought to justice.
