I am respectfully asking that you allow me to submit proper designated matter. The documents sent the end of February were incorrect; please understand that due to my disability a result from lupus and 2 strokes, I have many obstacles and was confused about what was supposed to be sent.

I am unable to complete things in as timely a manner as others may be able to. The lupus causes inflammation throughout my body including my brain and makes it extremely difficult to concentrate. The strokes have left me unable to organize things quickly and writing is difficult from a cognitive and legibility standpoint. The time frame requested was stressful and increased some of my symptoms. I was confused and overwhelmed which resulted in "brain freeze" and I believe I sent the wrong paperwork.

My point is that on that day I could not function normally and ultimately did not fulfill my task for you and the court properly; I just gathered items and don't actually recall what I sent to you and therefore jeopardized my case. Please note that I have found no medication that assists with these issues. I do not take drugs and am doing the best I can. I think you can see why I believe I am a full-fledged handicapped appellant.

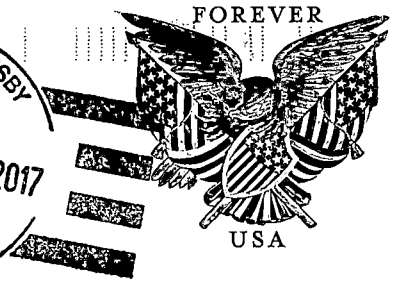
