MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Larry James Tyler respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Larry James Tyler respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Aaron Baynard Griswold with the Court of Appeals on March 10, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of State v. Johnny Jerome Boyd with this Court on February 28, 2017.4.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




