MOTION TO ENLARGE

The Appellant, above-named, would respectfully move this Court for an extension of time within which to make a response. The response of Appellant in the above action is due to be filed April 26, 2017. The Appellant move that the time for response be extended to (at least) May 26, 2017. This motion is made because the Appellant has not been able to respond within the allotted time for the following reasons:

1. Kershaw Correctional Institution, -where the Appellant is currently being held- is currently on a major "security locked-down" status. An officer was stabbed a few days ago, so presently, we-the inmates- have been informed that no inmate will be allowed to leave his cell for any reason what-so-ever. And that "this security locked-down" may last as short as two (2) weeks or as long as several months. Therefore, the Appellant has been prevented from access to the institution's law library to finish gathering information and prepare necessary copies, to complete my response in a timely fashion.

2. Once the "security Locked-down" is lifted, the Appellant would still have to sign-up AGAIN, (plus WAIT for a reply) to receive access time in the law library, and a date set to have copies made and notarize then mailed off.

3. Appellant would have made this Motion sooner had he known he could. The Appellant was only recently informed by the officer who works in the law library, that he could and should ask the court for an extension of time. There have been no prior extensions requested in this case.

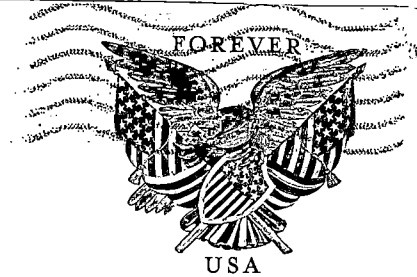

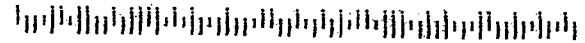
