
Dear Counsel:

On March 28, 2017, the Court requested clarification of the names of the parties from the case below that are pursuing this appeal. To date, we have not received a response. From our review, it does not appear that the Estates of James and Janie Bingley were parties to the action that gives rise to this appeal. If you do not clarify the appellants to this case within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, the appeal will be dismissed.

Furthermore, the notice of appeal was filed by Sherry Crummey on behalf of the Estates of James and Janie Bingley. Pursuant to Rule 264 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, you remain counsel on appeal until relieved by court order. We cannot accept any filings from Ms. Crummey because we cannot accept filings from a represented party. *See Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 347, 697 S.E.2d 527, 527 (2010) ("Since there is no right to 'hybrid representation' that is partially pro se and partially by counsel, substantive documents, with the exception of motions to relieve counsel, filed pro se by a person represented by counsel are not to be

accepted unless submitted by counsel.").
