
Rule 607 provides that the rate of \$3.25 per page shall be charged. Based on this rate, the estimated cost will be \$81.25. Upon receipt of your check in the amount of \$81.25 I will be able to place your request in line for production. If the transcript is less than 25 pages, I will refund the difference to you upon delivery of the transcript. If the transcript cost is more, the balance will be due prior to delivery of the transcript. If you would like to receive a hard copy of the transcript, please include an additional \$7.00 for postage fees. The transcript will be mailed as a priority delivery through the USPS.

Under the State rules, I have sixty (60) days to complete the transcript, after receipt of deposit. In addition, I am allowed to request from Court Administration thirty-day extensions, if necessary, to complete the transcript. You will be notified if extensions are granted.

If you desire to cancel the request for the transcript, a cancellation request must be made in writing. You will be responsible for payment of any portion of the transcript that has been completed.
