ORDER

The South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services (the Department) has filed an appeal from the Administrative Law Court's order reversing the Department's denial of Melissa Burris's parole and remanding the matter back to the Department for a new mental evaluation and a rehearing regarding Burris's parole. Because the ALC's order is not a final decision that is immediately appealable pursuant to section 1-23-610 of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2016), this appeal is dismissed. *See Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority v. South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 692 S.E.2d 894 (2010).
