
RE: Jeron Cook v. State; App. Case No: 2017-000816

Thank you for your assistance with this matter. Please contact me if any additional information is needed.

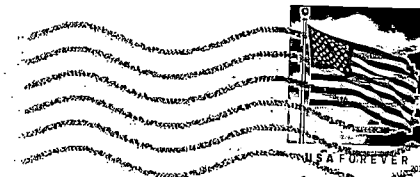
