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

Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it must contain the name of the judge from whose judgement the appeal is taken. The example given in Rule 267(a) may be helpful. The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 203, (SCACR). Specifically, the notice of appeal must contain the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
