**Appellants Response to Respondents Motion to dismiss ( or, in the alternative, motion to correct the record on appeal)**

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

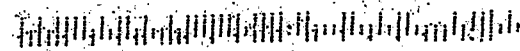
