

## ORDER

---

On April 5, 2017, this court required Appellant to provide a response addressing whether the deposition she sought to include in the record on appeal was actually presented to the lower court in its entirety. Appellant has now filed several new documents, which this court construes together as a response and a request for an extension of time to compile a correct record on appeal.<sup>1</sup> After careful consideration of the filings, Appellant's February 21, 2017 request to supplement the record on appeal with a deposition is denied. Appellant's request for an extension of time to compile a correct record on appeal is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve on Respondent a record on appeal that includes an actual copy of each of the matters listed in Appellant's designation of matter and Respondent's designation of matter. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall also file with this court a copy of a proof of service showing she served the record on appeal on Respondent. Due to the arduous procedural nature of this case, no further extensions will be granted absent a showing of extraordinary circumstances.
