ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on October 13, 2016. Appellant failed to cure the deficiencies contained with the service of his petition for rehearing, and this Court sent down the remittitur on January 4, 2017. Appellant has now filed a motion requesting that this court recall the remittitur and reinstate the appeal. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because Appellant failed to timely file a petition for rehearing with this Court, remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.
