The order was filed in December 28, 2016 in York County in The Court of Common Pleas. According to the judgment, I was ordered to pay the amount of \$5,456.71. However, I did not agree with it for the reasons:

1. Mr. Joseph Toth, the man who installed the "Touch n Buy" machine made me sign on the agreement paper, took it with him, wrote the number (48 months) contract on it, and a week later: he sent me a copy of it.
2. The machine does not work properly as it is mentioned on the lists. Many customers came to the store to pay their power and phone bills, but it not work for any of them.
3. He was drafting money out of my bank account for the prepaid phone cards sold at the store, but he refused to send me a statement of the sell and commission which supposed to show me how much money I made.
4. I gave away government cell phones for the food stamp recipients, and I was supposed to get paid \$8.00 from each cell phone; in fact, I did not.

I had to struggle financially for four months because I had to pay \$92.11 a month rent for the machine, and I was not getting paid my commission properly. I had to argue Mr. Joseph to help me solve the problem, but he did not even try.

This case needs to be justified and Mr. Joseph Toth must take accountability for all charges (\$5,456.71) and for the money that I should have to get paid from the prepaid phone cards and the government cell phones. He has to be brought to justice.
