To The South Carolina Supreme Court:

On January 20, 2017 the South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the above referenced case, the reason I was provided was that I (the appellant) failed to have a sufficient reason for a guilty plea appeal. However the Public Defender David P. Schwacke as my trial counsel filed the Notice of Appeal on November 3, 2016, I provided an 8 page letter in reference to the same as instructed by my attorney. In the letter I stated that the trial Judge made error of law, Constitutional issue of rights which are directly involved, There are Novel questions of law when the plea and issues subject to the Court. A Remittitur was sent from the Appellant Court to the lower that being Berkeley County Clerk of Court in Moncks Corner, SC. (see St. vs. Styles 381 SC442) (Rule 242b)

At this time even though I contacted the public defender previously assigned me on March 3, 2017 and asked him to ask for a new plea hearing or sentencing reconsideration I would like to know how I file a petition for a rehearing or reenstatement or for a petition for a writ of certiorari of the appellant Courts dismissal.
