

ORDER

Petitioner has filed a *pro se* notice of appeal from an order denying his request to relieve counsel and to appoint new counsel. The order also granted a continuance regarding the evidentiary hearing to be held in this case.

By statute and court rule, only a final decision or judgment in a post-conviction relief case is subject to appellate review. *Lewis v. State*, 368 S.C. 630, 630 S.E.2d 464 (2006). Since no final decision or judgment has been filed in this case, the notice of appeal is dismissed without prejudice to petitioner's ability to timely serve and file a notice of appeal once a final decision or judgment is filed with the clerk of the circuit court. The request to be represented by the Division of Appellate Defense is denied as moot. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
