MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until June 14, 2017**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. 5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




